

SERVICE LOCATIONS – ELECTRICAL

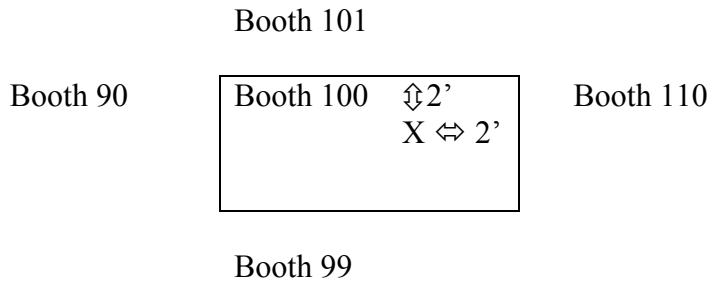

In order to better serve your electrical needs at the SECC, all island booths must submit a floor plan. All booth lines, including peninsulas, will have standard placement at the back of the booth unless otherwise indicated by you or your EAC (exhibitor-appointed contractor).

1) Inline Booth or Peninsula or G Hall:

- a) All power comes from the booth line for these style booths. If you are in need of power within your booth, indicate it on the floor plan with measurements from two sides and adjacent booth numbers.

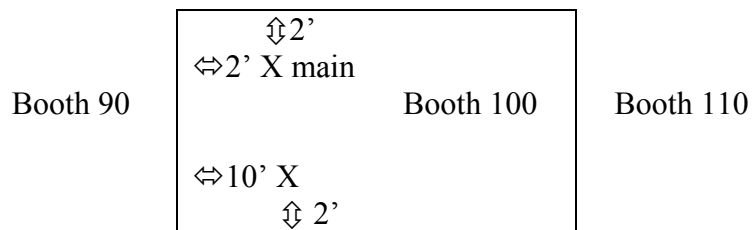

2) Island Booth:

- a) If you are not in need of floor work, you must still submit a floor plan that indicates where your power should be within your booth. All power in Halls A, B, C, & D is delivered from overhead catwalks.
- b) If you are in need of floor work, you must submit a floor plan with the main power drop indicated and each additional outlet location. Please give measurements from two sides as well as adjacent booth numbers.

Example:



All under carpet low voltage wire (i.e., telephone; Internet; video; audio CAT3, CAT6, RG11) and high voltage electrical wire, must be installed by SECC/SES electrical staff.
